- 1. This information identifies \$81.98 per square foot as the contractor-reported renovation cost of the existing building to remain in Option 5.
- 2. Using this \$81.98/SF, the calculated cost of renovating the current existing building would be \$16,802,594.
- 3. The Option 4 estimate to renovate the current existing building was \$18,258,114 or \$89.06/SF.
- 4. The additional cost per SF in the Option 4 estimate is due the inclusion of higher cost areas (kitchen, auditorium, 1931 building, etc.) that are not included in the renovated areas of Option 5.

\*This extrapolated cost does not include more costly renovations to the Auditorium, Kitchen, and 1931 Stone Building
